

Pull out the toxins



As toxin exposure has been increasing at a rate faster than the human body is genetically equipped to manage, this foundational approach **improves patient response to common toxin exposure.**

Step 1 _ Open up detox pathways

Glutathione, known as the master antioxidant for its ability to recycle other antioxidants, is an essential component of the body's detox system. Glutathione plays an integral role in both Phase 1 and Phase 2 detoxification. Glutathione becomes depleted when the body is faced with an overwhelming amount of toxins.

The problem traditionally is that glutathione is poorly absorbed by the body in supplement form. **Trifortify**[®], oral liposomal Glutathione, has overcome these barriers. Tri-Fortify[®] liposomal glutathione has been clinically researched and published in the European Journal of Clinical Nutrition in 2018.



Step 2 _ Remove the toxins

Mycotoxins

= Secondary mold metabolites released by spores in conditions when humidity and temperature are sufficient.

Glyphosate

= synthetic amino acid, most toxic herbicide in the USA. Glyphosate is classified as human carcinogen.

Heavy Metals

= Widespread contaminants like Cadmium, Mercury and Lead.





Step 3 _ Protect and replanish

Mineral status must be monitored during detoxification & chelation therapy.
